## PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

### MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS HELD ON 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021:

### REPORTS:

- a) VAS was use in December. No further news on the trial of the ANPR system. PP & HP volunteered to take over the VAS installation etc. from BS.
- b) The road that floods outside Valley Vineyards. FB has prepared a letter to be posted to SCC informing them of their responsibilities.
- c) Trees on the village field. GK has obtained an estimate of circa £300 plus VAT to tidy the hedges along 2 sides of the village field and car park. In view of the imminent nesting season, it was decided that these works should start ASAP.
- d) Community Partnership. Carried forward to next meeting due to BM absence.
- e) Reports of a possible unauthorised fibreglass factory/workshop. No further information yet received.
- f) The Beck supports collapsing. No further information available and ownership still unknown. Likelihood is that no works will take place by authorities.
- g) Festival of Suffolk 2022. FB &CP advised first event for 28/5/22 is confirmed.
- h) Lodge Lane bridge repainting. Unable to obtain quotes. HP will also enquire.
- i) DC/21/4643/EIA Proposed solar farm in Grays Lane. FB outlined the background to this and explained that no planning application has yet been made. FB suggested a joint open meeting with people from Wissett, Spexhall and Rumburgh for Weds 16<sup>th</sup> February in Wissett Village Hall to hear and note concerns in readiness for a joint Parishes response. FB to contact Chairs of both Parishes to discuss.
- j) Bridge at Mill Lane still not repaired, is on Highway's list for works.
- k) Old salt bin at Wash Lane. GK has inspected and disposal is an issue. CP will enquire about where it can be properly disposed of.
- l) Wash Lane verge and grips were reported to SCC for repair and tidy on 20/11/21.
- m) The W.I. Holly tree is dying and still in situ. FB to enquire if WI have been contacted.
- n) Footpath 6 will not be reinstated by SCC.
- o) A Jubilee Oak Tree has been donated by ESC. To be collected when available.

DC/21/5620/TPO Low Farm Manor Farm New Road Rumburgh IP19 0NJ Remove G1 Elm (approx. 25m) and replace by extending the existing planting.

DC/21/5640/HDG Low Farm Manor Farm New Road Rumburgh IP19 0NJ This Elm hedge is part of TPO 239A and application DC/21/5620/TPO also received. TPO 239A G1(Group consisting of 25 Elm) Remove G1 Elm (approx. 25m) and replace by extending the existing planting.
